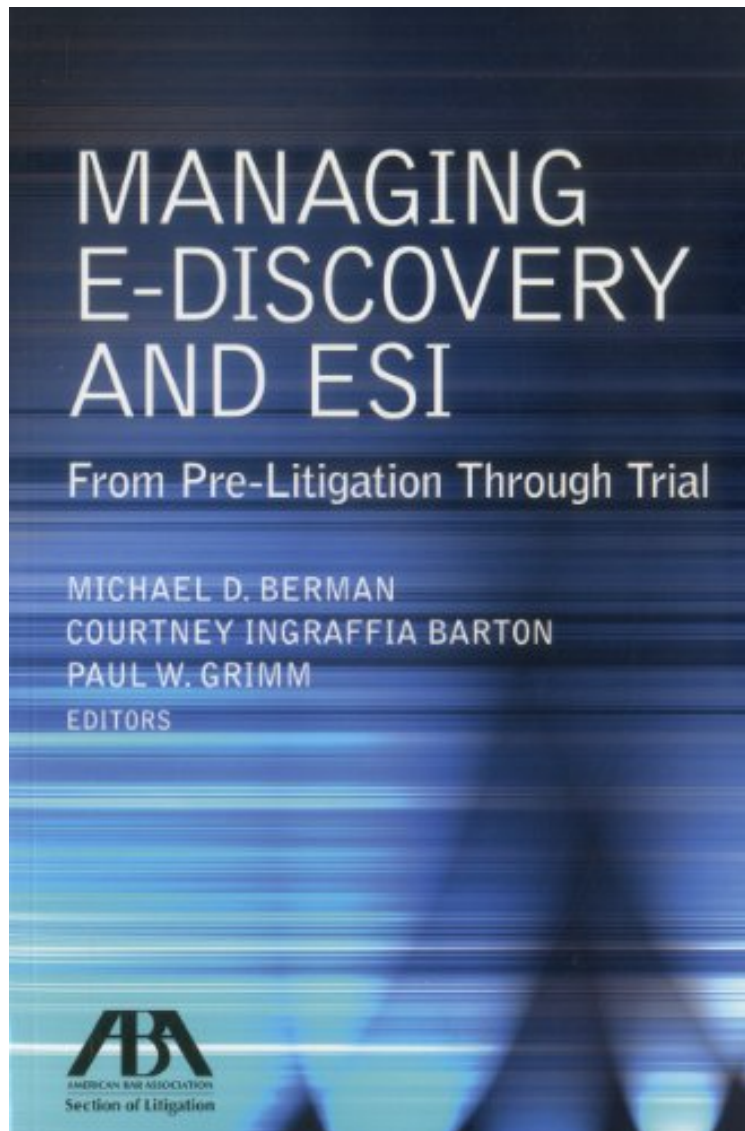

Here is the problem: I bought this book for a class and the substantive material is great, but the construction of the book itself is shoddy. The binding fell apart within the first week. I can barely open it without a new page falling out, which as any law student will tell you, is the last thing we need for the price we pay. I have had this book for 10 weeks and the binding feels like it's 30 years old. It might be the glue or maybe a soft cover binding just doesn't hold up against this many pages, but this book needs to be republished in another format. I'm disappointed.
