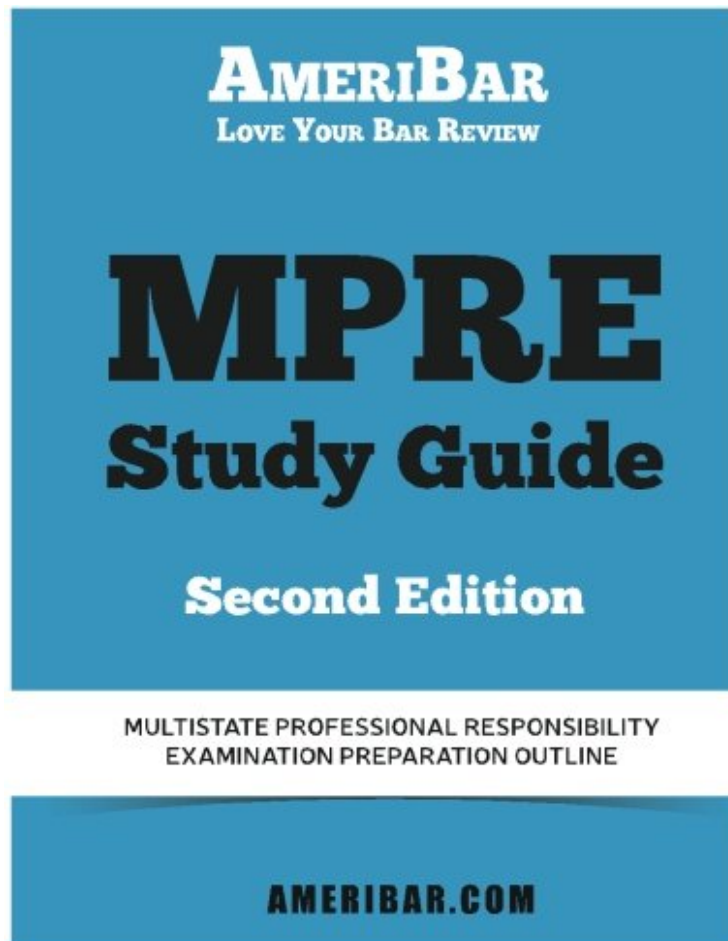

There are material mistakes to the questions presented as quizzes at the end of each section, questions are misplaced in the wrong sections, the questions themselves are poorly phrased and overly redundant of the previously stated material (and thus doesn't really require one to think through a question). Overall, a

poorly thought-out and poorly written regurgitation of the Model Rules of Professional Conduct with actual mistakes in the questions and answers which could materially affect one's ability to answer correctly on the MPRE.
