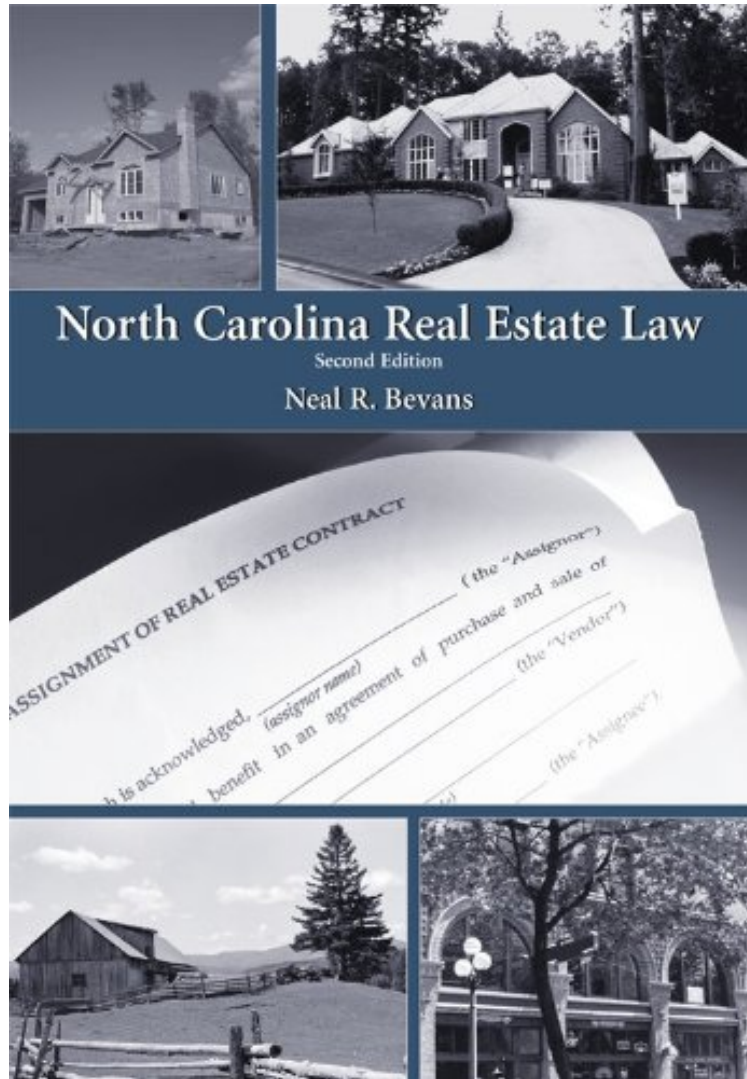

Although there are real estate texts available that concentrate exclusively on North Carolina law, they fall into two camps: theory or practice.
