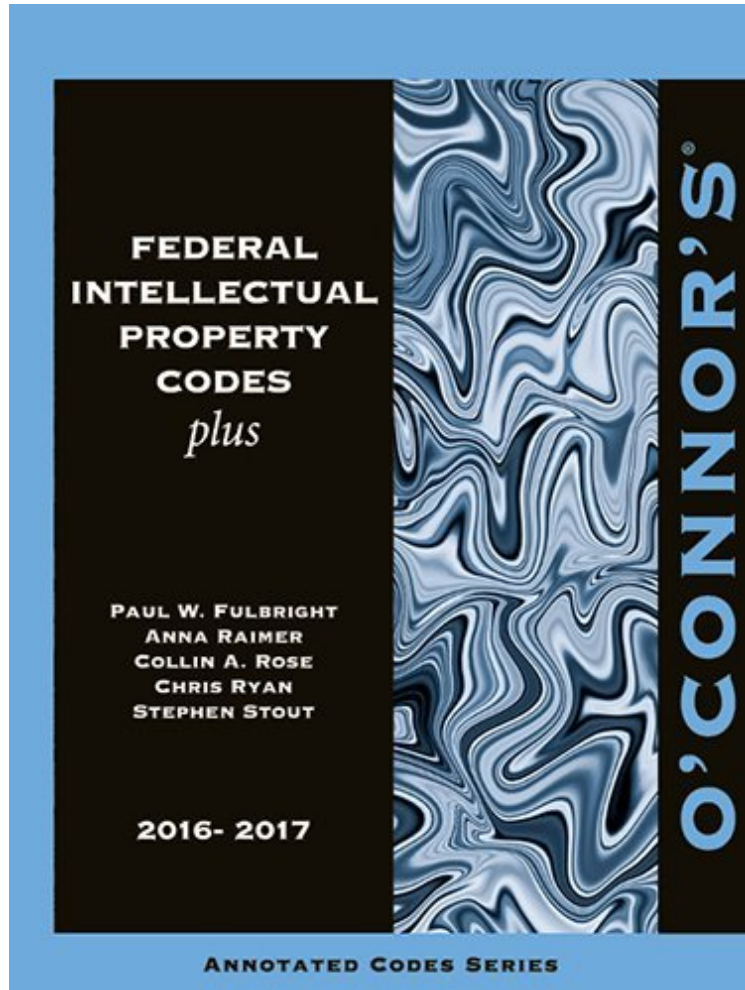

I have my students refer to the Annotated Code often, not only to read the statutory text, but also to use the wonderful case annotations that are provided to accompany each portion of the statute. In this way, students (or lawyers) gain a quick sense of how that text has been interpreted in actual cases. They can use these precedents to support arguments in class discussion and assigned memos. Each section also has citations to further research tools in legislative history and Nimmer's detailed treatise in copyright law. Thus students know exactly where to begin their research if they need further detail. My students who have graduated and gone into intellectual property practice tell me this remains an essential desk reference tool.
