

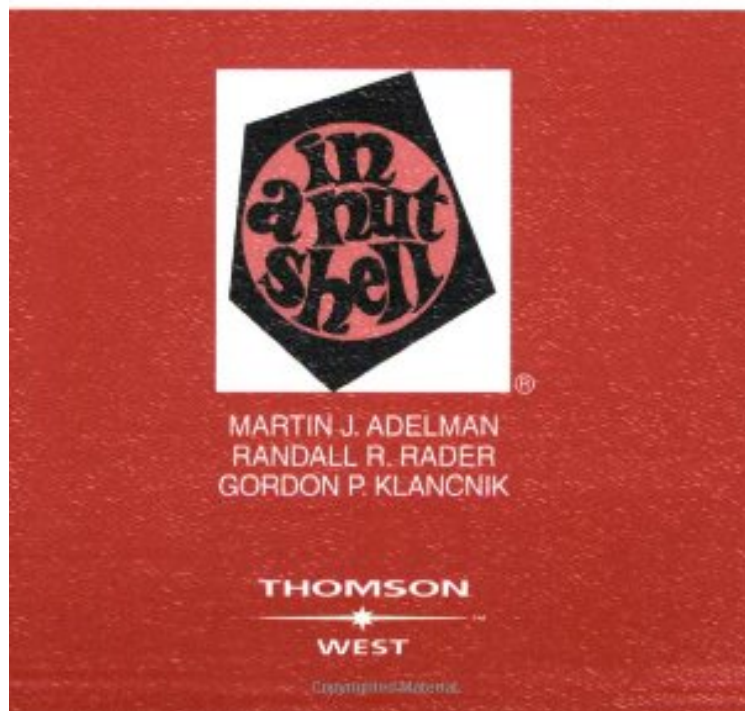

This quasi horn-book provides what it was meant to - basic law, rules, test, standards for legal analysis for final exams in law school. However, it is very basic and it neither goes into detailed legal analysis, nor provides deep case-notes. It's readable, but some language can be somewhat twisted in some parts, sections. It can probably be finished in a couple of hours, if read straight through, (despite 400+ pages) because the font is not very dense and the size of the book is very small. I recommend it to anyone preparing for patent law exam in 2-3 days (as I am right now). I wouldn't recommend using this book for reading during the course of the semester, as it is not very detailed and would be mostly futile.
