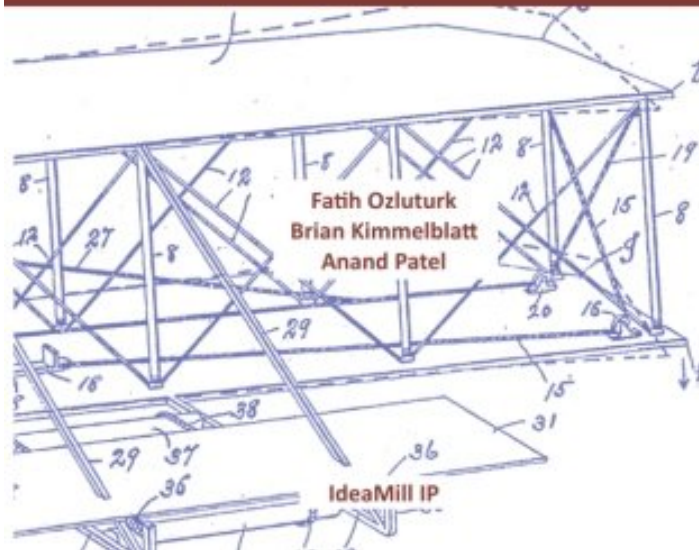

It's also does a good job explaining the most recent legislative changes. If you're looking for just enough material to be knowledgeable about the subject (and make taking to an IP lawyer a bit more productive) then this may serve you well. If instead you're looking for specifics about how to write a patent application, though, this book isn't for you.
