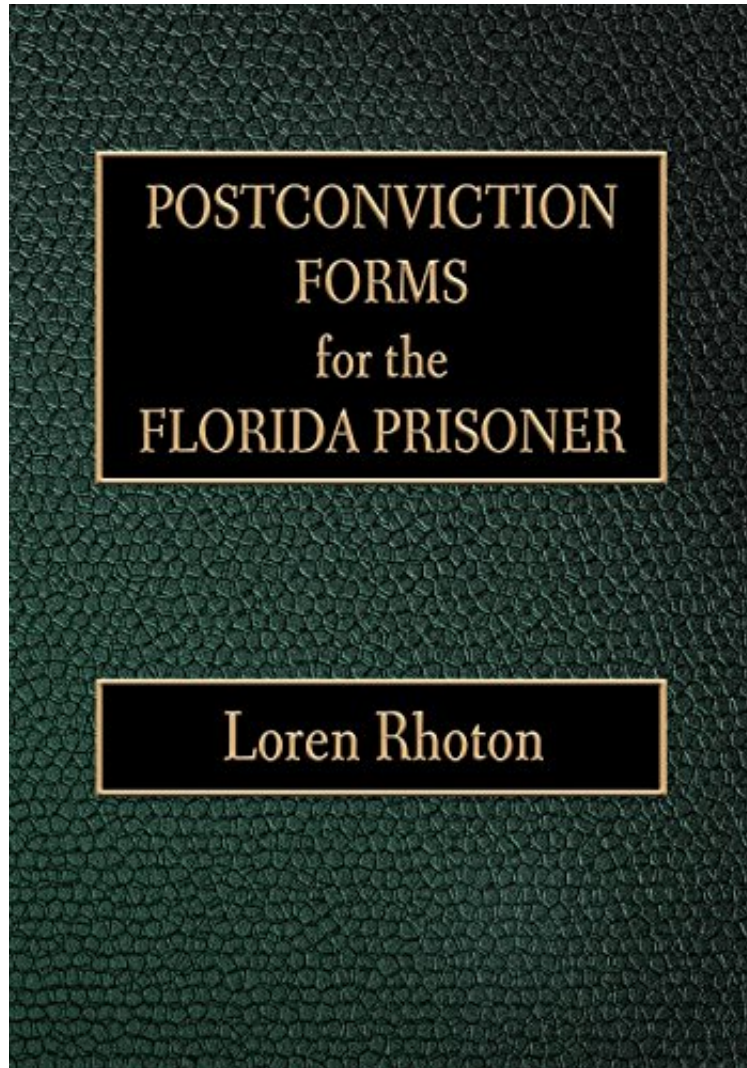

Mr. Rhoton was appointed by the Florida Supreme Court to the Florida Criminal Rules Steering Committee, Subcommittee on Postconviction Relief, which focused on rewriting Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.850. Mr. Rhoton worked on said subcommittee with judges and other governmental officials in an effort to improve the administration and execution of postconviction proceedings. Mr. Rhoton's role on the committee was to advocate for changes that were beneficial to postconviction litigants. For over a decade, Mr. Rhoton authored a bimonthly article, Post Conviction Corner, for Florida Prison Legal Perspectives. Thereafter he commenced publication of his own postconviction newsletter, The Florida Postconviction Journal. Selected articles from Post Conviction Corner and the Florida Postconviction Journal have been compiled and printed in a legal self-help book, Postconviction Relief for the Florida Prisoner.
