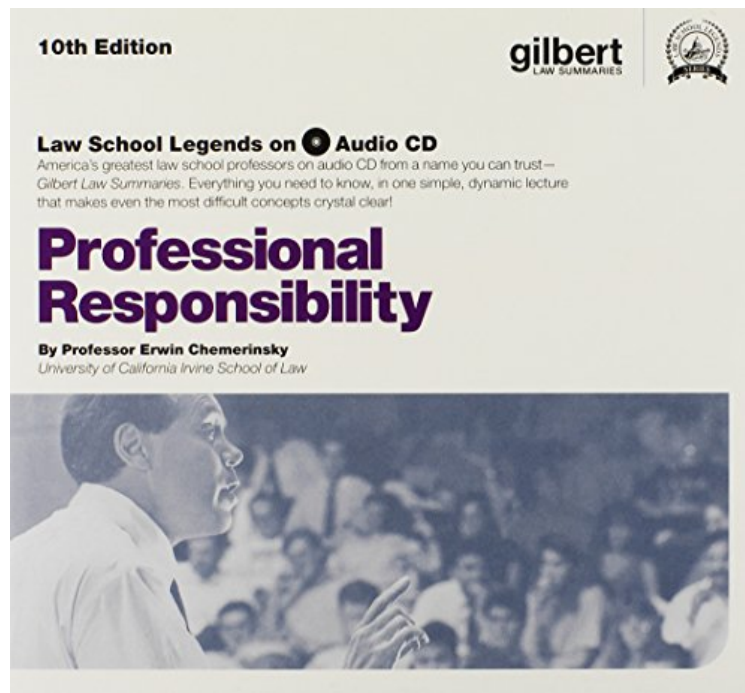

I was pleasantly surprised. Mr. Chemerinsky's voice is not at all dull. He is definitely following an "outline," which another reviewer saw as negative, but which I quite enjoyed because it breaks down the subject matter into a simple to digest format. After listening to the whole CD in one sitting (at 2x speed - which was a little fast at times, but otherwise fairly comfortable), I was pretty comfortable answering the questions that the CALI website had for the subject. The lecture was very dull - I think Erwin Chemerinsky merely read an outline. Other law lecture CDs I have listened to have been much more interesting and enjoyable to listen to. After I could endure listening no more, I sold my CDs by Chemerinsky and bought the Sum Substance CDs by John

Dzienkowski. The lectures by Dzienkowski were not great, but were reasonably good, tolerable to listen to, and covered the subject much more thoroughly than the Chemerinsky CDs.

The Professional Responsibility audio lecture on CD explains regulation of attorneys, bar admission, unauthorized practice, competency, discipline, judgment, layer-client relationship, representation, and withdrawal. It also discusses conflicts, disqualification, clients, client interests, successive and effective representation, integrity, candor, confidences, secrets, and past and future crimes. Other topics include perjury, communications, witnesses, jurors, the court, the press, trial tactics, prosecutors, market, solicitation, advertising, law firms, fees, client property, conduct, and political activity.
