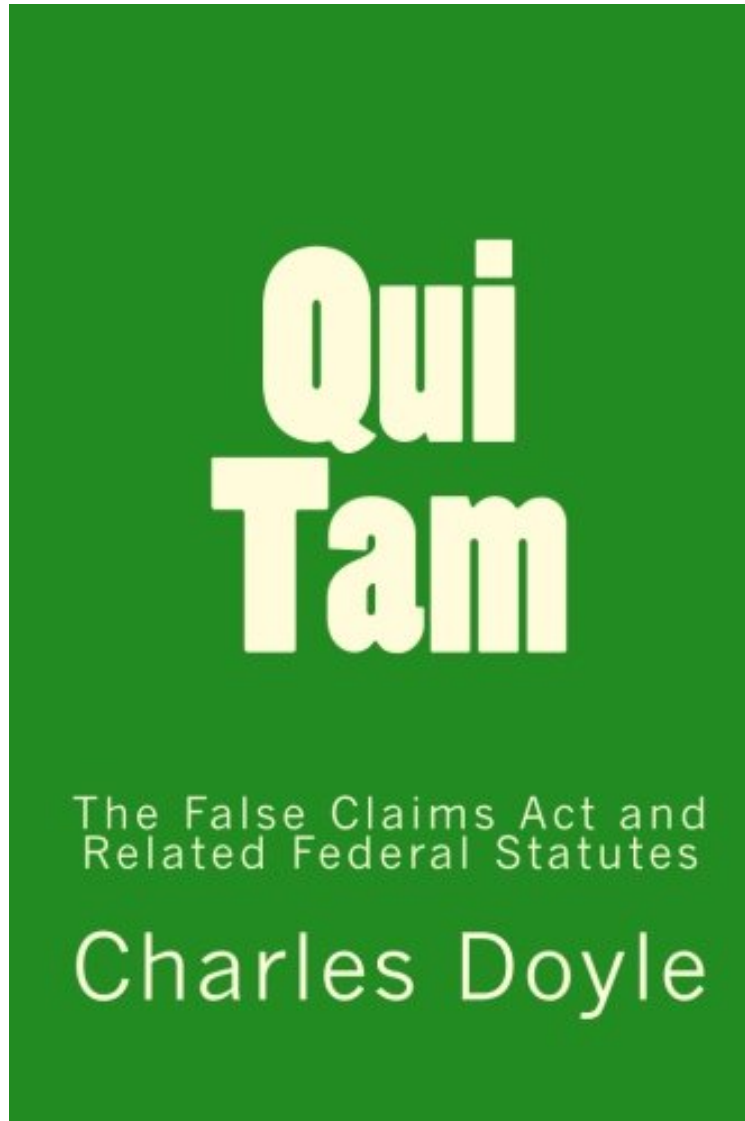

Fascinating little bookBy Matthew MontchalinAbout the size of a comic book, and not much thicker than one, this book is a handy little guide for someone who already knows how to look up cases and statutes, and only needs a little bit of a refresher on the acts that implement Qui Tam in the United States.But don't expect an in depth study of Qui Tam across national boundaries. Yes, it's a common law doctrine that is applicable to all common law countries, not just the United States, but this book confines its treatment to the law in

the United States, up through the year 2009. So at least it is reasonably current. Don't expect to find an in depth analysis of the law as it developed in England, Canada, or Australia. There aren't any references to the law's development there, such as would be reported in the English Reports or the Nisi Prius, or the like. Be thankful there is a reference or two in the first couple pages of the book, if you are still interested in taking your research in that direction, go to your local law library, and take it from there. But its small size saves space, and makes for easy carrying. The only shortcoming is the greyish 600 dpi typefaces using 4, 5, and 6 point faces on a dot matrix impact printer before they shot the negatives to making master plates for running through an offset press. You may be a little hardpressed to read this in dim lighting. The good news, though, is that there is perfect binding to hold the pages together (perfect binding is a term of art for using glue where the stem is). Sure am glad they didn't use spiral binding on a plastic stem. That would have made this thing miserable. The pages would fall out in a year if they did it that way. But as it is, I am happy to have gotten this, and added it to my collection. It looks like it will hold together for several years even though it isn't hardbound.
